Federal Constitutional Court Introduces SMS Notification Service for Litigants and Advocates

The Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan has launched an SMS notification service to facilitate timely dissemination of case-related information to litigants and advocates.

Under this initiative, litigants and their legal representatives will now receive automated SMS alerts regarding important case events, including registration of cases, fixation of hearings, and other procedural updates. This service aims to enhance transparency, improve access to information, and reduce the need for physical visits to the Court for routine inquiries.

The introduction of SMS notifications is part of the Court's broader effort to adopt modern information technology tools for efficient judicial administration and improved public service delivery. The service ensures that critical case information is communicated promptly, supporting smoother case management and better coordination with stakeholders.

The Federal Constitutional Court remains committed to strengthening institutional efficiency through responsible use of technology while safeguarding the integrity and confidentiality of judicial processes.
